Discussion:

Mike McGuire, CPA stated that the audit was completed and he met with the Finance Committee last week to review the audit, prior to today's meeting. The NPA will receive an unmodified opinion which is the best you can received from an audit. There were no material modifications. Mr. McGuire report a deficit in operations but it actually resulted in an increase of \$700k. A lot of the deficit is in recognizing pension expenses as a liability. We have a positive flow increase. There have been discussions concerning the 2023 Audit. We are looking to have 2023 done by December 2023 and then we will be back on track in 2025 for the 2024 audit. The summation and audit was distributed in the Board packet this month. No further questions or discussion was required.

Director Mack will provide information on what is the best approach to take and bring information back to the Board for a decision. General Counsel Crump discussed the agreement with 153 Halsey, LLC. Mr. Crump provided the basics of said agreement and the total amount being paid by web Health. Treasurer Speight inquired as to how the funds will be allocated. Director Mack suggested that the best use would be that we make pension benefit payments up-front and the rest in reserves. That suggestion was elaborated. General Counsel stated that we do not, as of now, have a time frame for receipt as they have to get a Certificate of Occupancy from the City first. We are hoping for the next thirty to sixty days. Upon completion of discussion, motion was approved by unanimous consent.

Chair Lewis briefly discussed the five (5) new vehicles and the need for a photo opportunity. The vehicles are in house and being outfitted with lights and signage.

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the City of Newark is authorized by N.J.S.A. 40:11A-6(l) to enter into and perform any and all contracts, execute any and all instruments, and do and perform any and all acts and things necessary or useful and convenient for the purposes of the authority; and

WHEREAS, 153 Halsey Newark, LLC is the owner of the real property located at 153 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey 07102 (Block 62, Lot 01, Qualifier C0002 on the tax map of the City of Newark, County of Essex, State of New Jersey) (the "153 Halsey Property"); and

WHEREAS, The Parking Authority has jurisdiction over the installation, collection and maintenance of parking meters on designated public streets throughout the City of Newark as set forth in the Interlocal Agreement (Resolution 7R1-be 080608), between the City of Newark and the Parking Authority, specifically the six (6) metered parking spaces located on Halsey Street and the one (1) metered parking space located on Bank Street; and

WHEREAS, a site plan illustrating/depicting, among other things, the location where the 153 Halsey Street Property meets the public street where relevant to this agreement is attached as Exhibit "A" attached hereto (and incorporated herein by this reference); and

WHEREAS, 153 Halsey Newark, LLC requires the removal six (6) metered parking spaces located on Halsey Street and the one (1) metered parking space located on Bank Street in the areas marked on Exhibit A (hereinafter, the "Curb Area"); and

WHEREAS, 153 Halsey has agreed to pay the Parking Authority for the permanent loss of six (6) metered parking spaces located on Halsey Street and the one (1) metered parking space located on Bank Street; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director requests authorization, from the Board of Commissioners, to enter into a contract with 153 Halsey Newark, LLC to compensate the Parking Authority for the permanent removal of six (6) metered parking spaces located on Halsey Street and the one (1) metered parking space located on Bank Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, THAT:

1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Executive Director to execute a contract with 153 Halsey Newark, LLC for the total amount of One Million Eighty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,087,000.00), paid out over the seven years, to compensate the Parking Authority for the removal of six (6) metered parking spaces located on Halsey Street and the one (1) metered parking space located on Bank Street. 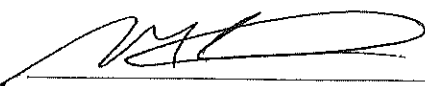

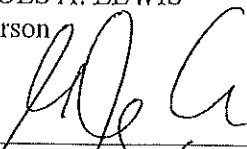
